



Allen Eagles Softball Kickball Classic Rules

Home Team

- The home team will be determined by a coin flip prior to each game.

Rosters / Lineups

- Teams must start and end each game with a minimum of 6 players – 3 males and 3 females
- 10 players max (including at least 4 females). Batting lineups must consist of alternating male and female kickers

Game Play

- Games are 25 minutes or the completion of 4 innings, whichever comes first
- Each inning will consist of 3 outs or 5 runs, whichever comes first

Pitching

- The pitcher must deliver the ball with one hand and a legal pitch stays in fair territory and any part of the ball enters any part of the strike zone
- Top of the ball may not be higher than the bottom of the kicker's knee. A strike will be called if these rules are met and the kicker does not make an attempt at kicking
- A pitch that does not enter the strike zone and is not struck at by the kicker or the ball bounces over home plate at a height that the top of the ball is higher than the bottom of the kicker's knee and is not struck at by the kicker a ball will be called.

Kicking / Running

The kicker is out when:

- Third strike is called
- Kicker attempts to kick the ball in front of home plate
- A foul tip is legally caught on the third strike
- He/She interferes with the catcher's ability to make a play

If the runner intentionally uses any part of their body above their shoulders to block the ball, the runner is out.

The batter is out in situations similar to softball (force outs, pop ups, etc.).

The runner is out when he/she is hit by a thrown ball; however, if a defensive player intentionally throws a ball at the runner's head, the runner will be deemed safe.

No bunting allowed.
